Good to excellent, except some points as detailed below</li> <li>(14) VENUE GOOD &amp; BAD POINTS?</li> <li>(a) ASHORE: <ul> <li>Facilities in Gdynia (measurement hall, offices, launching slip and crane) were excellent</li> <li>harbour (Gdynia) at a distance of the sailing area, time-consuming, but towing well organised</li> <li>less good: Social events were organised in Sopot, also time-consuming on the road for the crews</li> <li>bad: social events, especially prize-giving ceremony was mainly in local language, with large place given to organizers and sponsors, but very few to race officials and competitors.</li> <li>NOTE: in a near future, limited harbour facilities in Sopot could correct some deficiencies.</li> </ul> </li> <li>(b) AFLOAT: Just excellent, professional organisation, large number of rubber boats for committee, Jury, Safety, Measurers.</li> </ul>
