

The Micro Admiral's Cup

Organised by the Club organising the Microcup world championship in association with the International Micro Cupper Class Association

The Micro Admiral's Cup is an International Team Event challenged for through lands. Teams shall consist of three boats.

FOR INTERNATIONAL TEAMS OF 3 BOATS, one proto, one racer, one cruiser.

- Each boat of a team have to come from the same country (same sails letters).
- If a team can't present a boat from each category, it will be allowed to replace the missing boat with another from a slower categorie.
- Each team have to presente at least one cruiser. If not, the cruiser can't be replaced and the team will sail with only two boats.
- A team is at least two boats.
- The results will use the points of the overall results of the classement.
- A land may challenge more than one team. The first nationale team will be the moast complete, the last, the less complete according the rules above.
- Challenges will be deposed on the official form.
- Late Challenges may be accepted at the discretion of the Club organising the event in association with the International Micro Cupper Class Association.

A Small version of this event could take place during the Micro d'heure.

The captains cup is a "Wissel" Trophy which stays in the SNEH. The name of the winning countries will stay for ever on the trophy.
